CONDITIONS OF COMPETITION

1. THE CLASSIC

- 1.1 **LADIES OPEN DAY** - will be played over 18 holes of stroke play on Tuesday 12 October 2010 – open to Women.
- 1.2 **2 BALL AMBROSE MEDLEY** – will be played over 18 holes Stroke Play in 2 person ambrose format on Wednesday 13 October 2010 – open to Men and Women.
- 1.3 **VETERANS CLASSIC** – will be played over 18 holes of stroke play on Thursday 14 October 2010 – Open to members Carbrook or other recognised Veterans Golf Associations.
- 1.4 **SPONSORS DAY** – will be played over 18 holes Stroke Play in 4 person ambrose format on Friday 15 October 2010. This event is closed to sponsors.
- 1.5 **MEN'S CARBROOK CLASSIC** – will be played over 36 holes of stroke play on Saturday 16 and Sunday 17 October 2010.
- 1.6 **WOMEN'S CARBROOK CLASSIC** - will be played over 36 holes of stroke play on Saturday 16 and Sunday 17 October 2010.

2. CHAMPIONSHIP COMMITTEE: A Championship Committee, appointed by Carbrook Golf Club, shall have sole management and control of the event. The Championship Committee reserves the right to: (a) fix and/or alter starting times, (b) in the event of bad weather, or for any other reason, either shorten the contest or fix another day/venue, (c) vary any condition should they deem it advisable, (d) reject any entry without assigning any reason therefore. The decision of the Championship Committee will be final in all matters and in the absence of a full committee, such members as may be present at the time may give a decision and any decision so given shall be deemed to be a decision of the full Championship Committee.

3. ENTRIES:

- 3.1 The Championship events are open to all male and female amateur golfers with an Australian Handicap. Some requirements exist for each individual event from Tuesday - Thursday.
- 3.2 Entries without a Golf Link number must be supported by a printed handicap record endorsed by an official of the player's home club.
4. **PUBLICITY:** Carbrook Golf Club arranges publicity before, during and/or after this Championship. It is a condition of entry that all players assent to references to them, and pictures of them in practice and play being published via any medium (including the internet).
5. **PRIVACY:** Carbrook Golf Club may retain the personal details (i.e. name, address, handicap) of entrants in this Championship on its records. The purpose of doing so is such that information on other future events conducted by Carbrook Golf Club (or other parties) can be forwarded as deemed appropriate by Carbrook Golf Club. This information will not be available to any other organisation. Any person may have their details removed from this database by phoning the Carbrook Golf Club on 3287 6499.
6. **DRESS REGULATIONS:** It is a requirement of this event that all players must comply with the dress standards of the club.
7. **RULES:** The Rules of Golf as adopted by the R&A Rules Limited will apply together with the Local Rules as are approved by the Championship Committee.
8. **BALL:** It will be obligatory for all competitors in all events to play with a ball which is named in the current list of Conforming Golf Balls issued by the R&A. Penalty for breach of this condition: Disqualification.
9. **MOBILE PHONES:** The use of mobile phones by players and/or caddies during the play of any competition round is prohibited. Serious breaches of etiquette may result in disqualification.
10. **PACE OF PLAY:** Rule 6-7 will be strictly enforced by the Committee. Players found to be out of position will receive a warning. Failure to improve their position may result in penalties to the group or individuals as the Committee deems appropriate.
11. **TIES:** In the event of a tie for the Men's Carbrook Classic, play shall continue hole by hole over such holes as the Championship Committee shall decide, until one player gains at least a one stroke advantage. The breaking of ties for all other events/trophies will be determined by use of the Australian Count-back System.
12. **PROTESTS:** Protests must be lodged in writing with the Championship Committee no later than 10 minutes after the conclusion of the day's play except on the final day when they must be lodged no later than 5 minutes after the conclusion of play.
13. **PRESENTATION OF TROPHIES:** The Men's Carbrook Classic Championship will be awarded to the players with the lowest gross score over 36 holes. The Women's Carbrook Classic will be awarded to the player with the lowest 36 hole Nett score. Trophies will be presented at the conclusion of each day's play (excluding Saturday), and will be awarded at the determination of the Championship Committee.
